

Hot counter VSR

Installation and operating instructions OI-204521-1

1. Place the Hot counter on a level surface, and adjust level.
2. Remove all protective plastic from all surfaces, inside and outside.
3. Insert the plug into an easily accessible socket, which is easily accessible after assembly.
Please check technical documentation about power type.
4. Press the green main switch to start hot counter.
5. The thermostat for the cabinet is set at 75^0 C , and for toplate at 90^0 C . Set temperature can be adjusted by pressing both buttons. The display shows set temperature. Then press the upper or lower key for higher or lower value. Confirm by pressing both buttons and the thermostat shows the operating temperature. Any other adjustment to the thermostat parameters must only be performed by qualified technical personnel.
6. The hot counter has to be heated to right temperature before use, and food must at least have serving temperature before filling.
7. This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand hazards involved. Children shall not play with the appliance. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision.
8. **Cleaning:** Clean the Hot counter with mild soap and water, do not use soap with abrasives, chlorine, iodine or fluorine.
OBS! Never use high-pressure water or water hose for cleaning!
9. **Service:** Turn main switch (thermostat) in off position and pull out the main cord. Remove the front panel. Thermostats and electrical system is now available. At the service the heating element screwed operation panel loose, wires disconnected, and lock washers loosened. OBS! Only qualified personnel or service agents are allowed for this operation.
10. Replacement of main cord has to be done by qualified personnel.
